

PSYCHOSOCIAL RISK ASSESSMENT

Psychosocial risk refers to factors in the work environment that can affect the mental and emotional health of workers, such as:

- Work-related stress
- Excessive workload
- Lack of control over work
- Lack of social support
- Job insecurity
- Workplace harassment
- Discrimination

Evaluating employees' emotional well-being is not just necessary to enhance their performance but also a legal obligation.

These factors can lead to psychological and emotional problems such as:

- Anxiety
- Depression and burnout
- Work absenteeism
- Decreased work quality
- Job dissatisfaction

Failing to address them in the workplace can have legal and financial consequences for the company, including facing lawsuits, fines, and penalties.

Federal regulations establish economic penalties of up to USD 25,000 for workplaces that fail to comply with the monitoring and care of employees' emotional health.

Additionally, talent loss and turnover increase recruitment and training costs and impact the organization's reputation and image.

Organizations must psychosocially evaluate their personnel at least once every two years.

What should be done?

Identifying, assessing, and managing psychosocial risk in the workplace and implementing preventive and intervention measures, such as:

- Policies for preventing workplace harassment
- Workplace wellness programs
- Stress management training
- Promoting a healthy and equitable work environment
